

YHO CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY

In the past five years, I have not been employed by, received research support or funding from, or had any professional relationship with any entity directly involved in the production, manufacture, distribution, or sale of tobacco products (including vapes, heated tobacco, nicotine pouches) or alcohol products.

I declare that I and/or the organisation(s) which I am representing do/does not receive any direct or indirect financial assistance, funding, other than taxes, or other fiscal duties, court-mandated payments, or settlements from the tobacco or alcohol industry, or any entity working to further its interests, nor have I/we within the past five years. Indirect support includes arms-length organisations and networks with funding links to the industry, such as Smoke-Free World (formerly FSFW) and GFN/KAC.

I recognise and acknowledge the importance of Article 5.3 of the Framework Convention on Tobacco Control and its Guidelines that protect the development of tobacco control policy from the influence of the tobacco industry and I adhere to the spirit of principles of Article 5.3 notably in setting and implementing public health policies with respect to tobacco and alcohol while ensuring the protection of these policies from commercial and other vested interests shall be ensured.
